

## Special Recess Bulletin – No 12 Friday 5 June

Dear Leaders and Members

I am sorry to be bothering you with another Bulletin but I just want to clear up an issue before you become too concerned.

If and when we resume weekly singing I will not be requiring that everyone has the Covid Ap or have had an Influenza injection. In my earlier bulletin this week I did say that we would make that a requirement to attend a practice.
